

# Educators Rising Honor Society

Honor Society distinction recognizes the academic accomplishments of student members. To qualify students must:

- ▶ Be a junior or senior in high school
- ▶ Have a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA
- ▶ Be an Active-level, dues-paying member of Educators Rising
- ▶ Pay a \$5 application fee

The Honor Society is a resume-building opportunity for students and a great way to provide students with national recognition for their academic achievements.
